Napa, California – The Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency (NCTPA) Board of Directors voted on Wednesday, February 18, 2009 to release the initial scope of work to its member jurisdictions for action for the SR 29 Gateway Corridor Feasibility Study. NCTPA and Solano Transportation Authority (STA) have worked together to identify the various steps and elements that should be considered for the Hwy 29 Gateway Corridor project. NCTPA and STA are also working to identify and secure funding for this effort which is estimated to cost approximately \$200,000 and take about twelve months after the award of a contract. Objectives of the study are: (1) congestion relief; (2) to improve bicycle and pedestrian access; (3) to plan for future transit services; (4) to improve the aesthetics and cohesiveness of this “gateway” corridor; while ensuring each jurisdiction remains visually distinct; and (5) to improve safety.
