Dear PCC Applicant:

Attached you will find an Application for Appointment for the Napa County Paratransit Coordinating Council (PCC). Please return the completed application to Deborah Brunner at NCTPA at 707 Randolph Street, Suite 100, Napa CA 94559. You may use additional pages, if necessary, and include other documentation if you like. The vacancies will remain open until filled.

The PCC is an advisory committee to the Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency (NCTPA) Board of Directors. NCTPA is Joint Powers Agency comprised of the Mayors and a Councilmember from each jurisdiction, and the Chair of the Napa County Board of Supervisors and one other Supervisor. The primary purpose of the PCC is to advise the Board on the availability of transportation for persons with special needs and seniors while meeting the needs of the general population. Other PCC functions are:

- To increase the coordination, availability and effectiveness of special transportation services.
- To review final proposals before federal, state and/or local paratransit funding is requested and makes recommendations on these proposals to the Napa County Transportation Planning Agency, the Napa County Board of Supervisors, the governing boards of the five municipalities, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission, and other appropriate agencies.
- To provide the general public with a forum to discuss common goals and recommend actions affecting paratransit services with the agencies, organizations and individuals who are PCC members.
- To encourage the use and development of effective and efficient transit services for those who are transit-dependent channel input and suggestions to existing paratransit services in the county; keep service providers and funding agencies informed of the needs of transit-dependent people.
- To offer assistance to groups and/or agencies applying for federal, state and/or other appropriate funds for paratransit services; maintain awareness of potential funding sources; disseminate local and regional transportation information to as wide an audience as possible within the county, and promote coordination of transit services countywide.

The PCC meets the first Wednesday each month at 1:30 pm at NCTPA. No meetings are held in the month of August. All meetings are open to the public.
