**NOTICE OF TRANSPORTATION FUND FOR CLEAN AIR PROGRAM CALL FOR  
PROJECTS AND COUNTY WORKSHOP**

The Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency (NCTPA) would like to announce an open call for projects for the Transportation Funds for Clean Air (TFCA) Program. The TFCA Program is a grant program funded by a \$4 surcharge on motor vehicles registered in the Bay Area. This generates approximately \$22 million per year in revenues. The purpose of the TFCA program is to provide grants to implement the most cost-effective projects in the Bay Area that will decrease motor vehicle emissions, and thereby improve air quality. Funds are available to public agencies, and some non-public entities may be eligible to apply for these funds, but only for certain clean air vehicle projects.

NCTPA will be holding a public workshop for 2010-2011 TFCA projects on Friday, February 19<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 PM at 707 Randolph Street, Suite 100 in downtown Napa. Applications for the 2010-2011 TFCA project cycle will be due to NCTPA on or before Friday, March 19<sup>th</sup> 2010 by 5:00 PM. Project applications will be scored on a cost effective and project readiness basis.
